Prior to her tenure at the Sunday Telegraph, Patience was City Editor of the Times from 1997 and wrote an influential business column. She has completed stints on the business sections of the Mail on Sunday, Daily Mail and Sunday Times, and has edited the trade magazine Retail Week.

In 2001 she won the Wincott Senior Journalist of the Year Award, and in 2003 was named the London Press Club Business Journalist of the Year.

In addition to her on-going journalistic interests, Patience has been appointed to the boards of Barclays plc and Barclays Bank as a non-executive director, and is also a director of Shaftesbury plc.
