CIVIL ENGINEERING JOURNALIST — David Fowler (New Civil Engineer), with commendation to Simon Montague (New Civil Engineer), sponsored by Ove Arup & Partners.

NEWS REPORTER — Tony Yorke (Building), with commendations to Richard Watson (New Civil Engineer), Paul Dempsey (New Builder) and Andrew Duffy (Contract Journal), sponsors Willett Limited.
