

## National Journalism Awards 2018 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The National Journalism Awards are judged by a broad-based panel of influential journalists, including previous Award winners, and industry professionals draw from the built environment. For full list of judges [please click here](#).

All entries (including the two Magazine categories) should be registered online and include one of the following payment options:

### Individual Editor or Journalist rate

Single entry: £80 + VAT (£16) = £96

Multiple entries, all categories: £150 + VAT (£30) = £180

### Freelance Journalist rate

£60 + VAT: £12 = £72 for a Single entry or Multiple entries, all categories.

**You can pay by PayPal or request an invoice; these options are available to you when you submit your entry online, see payment button on the online entry process. Please note the following:**

- Entry to the Awards scheme also entitles each journalist **full** membership benefits for 2018/19. Membership is subject to ratification by the IBP board of management.
- **All editors and journalists that enter the Awards will be invited to attend the Awards Dinner as IBP's guest.**
- The Awards are open to editors, staff journalists and freelance journalists, working for business magazines, **national and regional newspapers**. All entries in each category must relate to the built environment sector, specifically: architecture, civil engineering, commercial property, construction, design and housing/residential property. Please see category explanations in the entry template.
- Individual articles cannot be submitted for more than one category.
- There is a single winner in each category. Judges may make up to **six** nominations in each category.
- Nominated finalists, from whom the winner will be announced at the Awards Presentation Dinner, will be the guests of IBP and hosted by the category sponsor.
- Nominated finalists should make every effort to attend or be represented (by a colleague) at the Awards Dinner.
- No correspondence on the judges' decisions will be entered into.
